

Sound Technician Job Description

Spiritual qualifications:

1. Mature follower of Jesus Christ
2. Desire to serve the body of Christ
3. Humble attitude; desire to glorify God above all

Church requirements:

1. Become an active member of PCC
2. Fully affirm PCC statements of faith
3. Agree to uphold the church covenant
4. Team player; on board with church's vision and direction
5. Works well with pastors and church leadership
6. Follows the lead of the church music director and worship leader
7. Reports directly to church music director

Technical and work requirements:

1. Strong knowledge of sound equipment (sound board; microphones; wireless equipment; etc.)
2. Able to mix sound live, engineer live stream audio, and record events as requested
3. Able to achieve the particular sound requested by the music director or worship leader
4. Able to train others to help with running sound
5. Able to work well with the musicians and live stream personnel
6. Able to troubleshoot and/or purchase new equipment as needed
7. Continually looking for ways to improve sound quality
8. Open to further educational opportunities as provided by the church

Time Commitments (about 6 hours/week)

1. 2 hours on Wednesday nights
 - run sound for Praise Team rehearsal
 - run sound for Worship Choir
2. 4 hours on Sunday mornings (8-12)
 - set up and rehearse musicians for Sunday
 - run sound for both services
3. The sound technician would also be responsible for running sound for special services such as Holy Week, Cantatas, etc.
